

# Stichting Ranking Digital Rights Network

## Activity Report (2019)

Stichting Ranking Digital Rights Network (SRDRN) is a non-profit organization registered in The Netherlands as of July 28, 2017.

The purpose of SRDRN is to support the work of a global network of research and advocacy partners who share RDR's mission: to create standards and incentives for tech companies to respect and protect the human rights of internet users.

During 2019, the main focus of SRDRN shifted from setting up its governance, administrative, and financial infrastructure to raising funds that would enable the hiring of staff and commencement of programmatic activities. Specifically, we:

- Met with representatives of Dutch organizations engaged in human rights benchmarking and digital rights issues;
- Secured funding for a scoping study to identify opportunities for SRDRN to leverage the research and methodology produced by our U.S.-based partners at New America's Ranking Digital Rights program, to make a useful and effective contribution to European debates on how policymakers can best foster and protect digital rights;
- Commissioned a consultant to commence the scoping study (completed in early 2020), which identified opportunities for SRDRN to commence activities that would make a unique contribution to the European digital rights field.

SRDRN's top priority for 2020 is to obtain funding to engage consultants to support programmatic activities consistent with the long-term organizational objectives described on [our website](#). In 2020-2021 our focus will be on supporting European research and advocacy networks dedicated to fostering corporate respect for digital rights along with the government regulations and policies that are consistent with international human rights standards.

The start-up team will then build out the organization and its activities as further funding is secured.
